Project Brief: - Through this project, Bundelkhand Sewa Sansthan has worked in 150 villages of Babina and Badagaon block of Jhansi district to save children from the issues of child labour, child marriage, child sexual exploitation, child trafficking and also to help children and their parents and Work has been done to make communities aware of child protection. By activating the child protection committees of the government, child protection activities were conducted smoothly. To bring maximum awareness among the children, an oath was taken in schools and colleges not to do child marriage, in which a large number of children and teachers participated. By coordinating with the Labor Department and the Women and Child Welfare Department, a continuous campaign was run to rescue the children involved in child labour, and various awareness meetings and programs were organized.

Adult literacy program is being run by Shiv Nadar Foundation for many years. Taking this program forward, Shiv Nadar Foundation is being run through Bundelkhand Seva Sansthan in Madavara block of Lalitpur from August 2023.

The impact of Shiksha Plus program (Adult Literacy Programme) being conducted in 11 villages of Madavara block of Lalitpur district of Uttar Pradesh is having a very positive impact. When people above 15 years of age are taught alphabets through laptop and projector. Bundelkhand Seva Sansthan, in collaboration with Shiv Nadar Foundation, has educated 2500 people from 15 villages in the Education Plus program from 2023 to 2024.

Water Harvesting & Agriculture Based Livelihood Project (WHALP)

Project Brief: -In this Program Bundelkhand Sewa Sansthan (BSS) have initiated for the Revival of Rivers or Nala, Ponds/Tanks, through DOHA Modal Structure, Campaign of Public and Community awareness on Water Conservation issues, BSS have Selected 8 Doha Modal water Structure for revival from Bachhrai Lalitapur Makripur Makripur (Tank) Narahat Villages of Lalitpur District . BSS have been successfully completed De-siltation or restoration work of 8 water Structures. This experience demonstrated clear benefit in terms of increased storage capacities of the Nalas, enhanced soil fertility, better crop productivity and incomes to farmers. The processes followed in mobilizing informal groups of farmers for this purpose and in systematically organizing the distribution through transparent monitoring processes, have insights that are useful to similar mainstream initiatives. We have Conducted Training of Water Security Plan, Water budgeting, water Conservation awareness activity with farmers. Following targeted data have achieved from this program:-

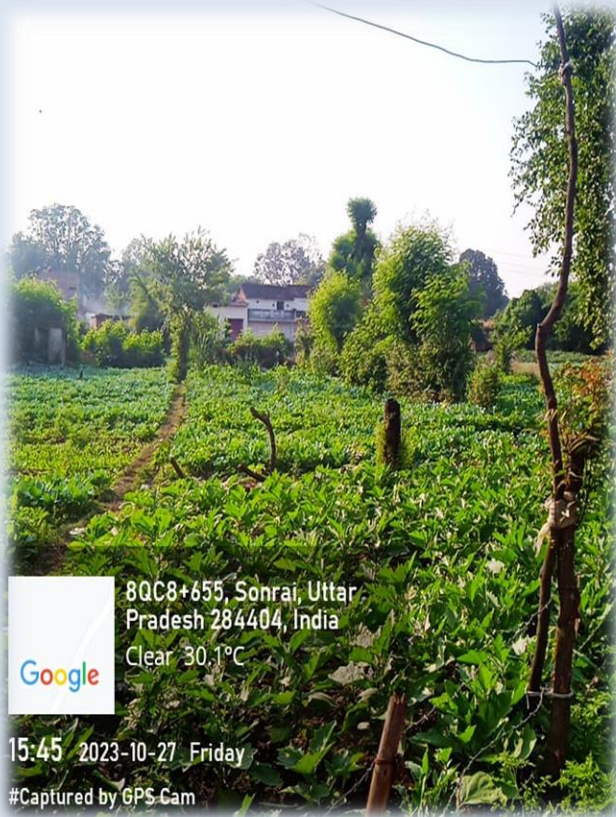
